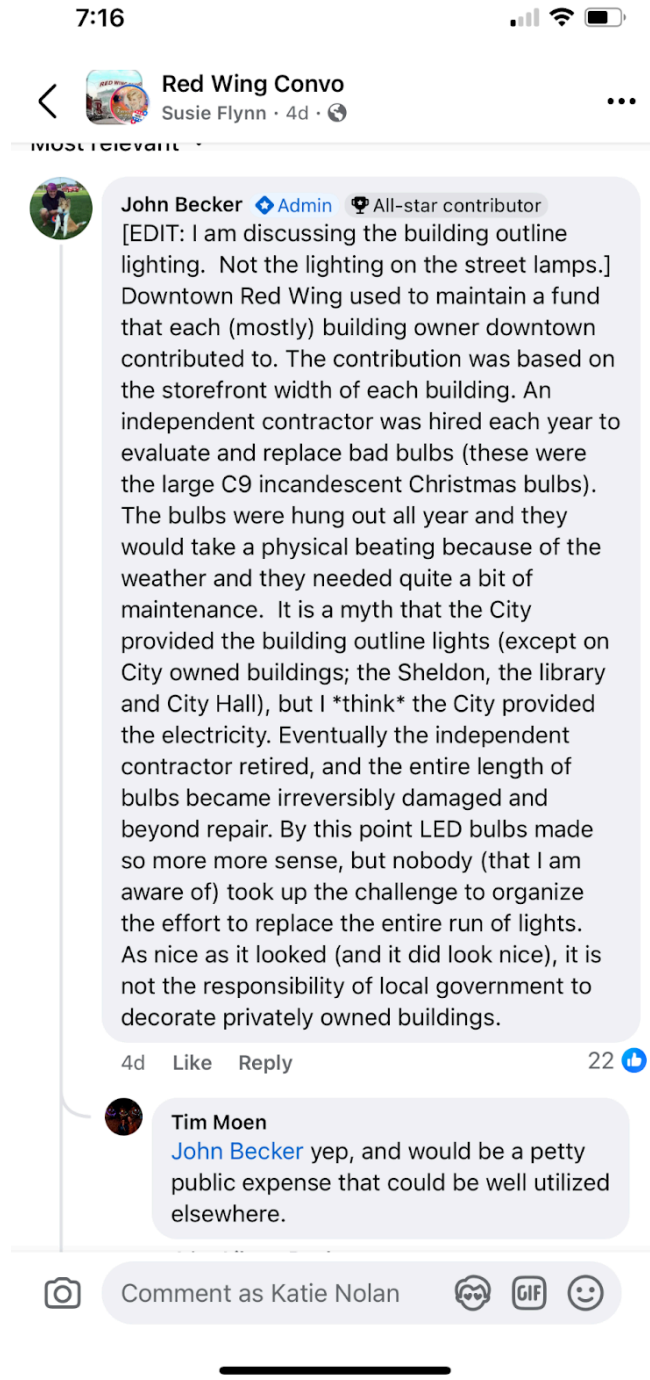

Questions

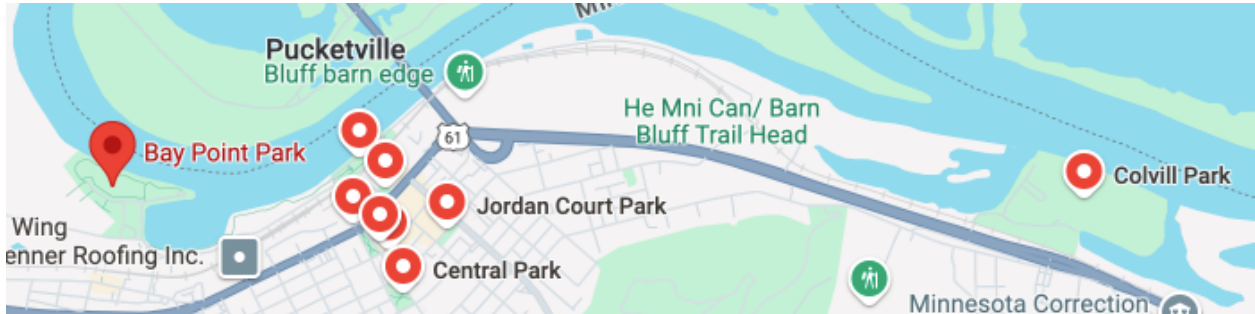
- Do we want to break volunteers into smaller groups so that multiple statues can be cleaned at once? Each group would require a city staff person to supervise. How many groups?
